**Read actively** and record any questions or interesting pieces you find to bring up in class/discussion/office hours. Even just talking about these issues with a friend will help solidify your understanding.



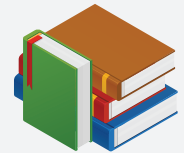
Taking notes in the **Question -> Evidence -> Conclusion** method, ensuring quality notes.



**Prioritize** the rest of your readings into what can be read, skimmed or skipped.



The frequency that these readings are mentioned in the **syllabus** or lecture is good clue to prioritizing.



Skimming for **definitions and key terms** leaves out the comprehension that ties it all together. It's helpful to locate these pieces in the conclusion section of readings or major points made in class.
